Major Responsibilities:

- 1. Organize, promote, and carry out new and additional programs, leagues, and tournaments as specified in the service contract.
- 2. Promote new programs to beginner players.
- 3. Find instructors to teach beginner programs.
- 4. Help transition players created in beginner programs into existing USTA league play.

Goals:

- 2. Meet participant goals set for each program.
- 3. Self-sustain programs after 2 years where program revenue will replace grant funds after 2 years.
