- Amenities
 - T-shirts for players (or similar gift)
 - Player party or lunch
 - Water, fruit, and ice at each site
 - Player amenities (host choice)
 - Seating on court for players
- Addresses or directions to/from sites and hotels
- Hotel room blocks with special rates
- Volunteers to run site desks, registration, etc.
- Local interest literature on restaurants, shopping, tourism, etc.
- Allocation of Championship courts (back-up courts and practice courts are a plus)
- Internet/Computer/Printer access at host site
- Roll-drys at every site

- Local Winner and Championship Awards
- Tennis Balls
- Staff including Tournament Director, Referee, and Marketing/Promotions staff
- Tournament Schedule
- Captain's Packets
- Training for site volunteers
- Staff accommodations (if not comped by a local hotel) and expenses
- Site desk supplies
- National/Sectional/State Sponsor banners
- Collect fees and registration information
