The Tennis Foundation of Mississippi is pleased to announce that Nick Barone of Jackson & Louis Nash of Oxford are the 2022 inductees into the Tennis Foundation of Mississippi Hall of Fame. The inductees into the Tennis Hall of Fame have long been associated

with tennis in the state and through their play, support, and generosity have left an unmistakable imprint on Mississippi tennis.

Nick Barone is a native of Chicago and his father introduced him to the game of tennis at the age of three. His dad had high ambitions for his tennis career, putting together a structured training schedule in order to compete at the national level on the junior circuit.

"I grew up as a junior player in the era of Pete Sampras, Andre Agassi, Jim Courier and many other greats. I will never forget watching these guys play in national tournaments when I was around 15 years old and thinking every one of these guys are going to make it on the pro tour. That sound the ball made off their rackets was just different than all their peers. As everyone knows now, they made their mark early in their careers and set a new standard of high velocity tennis. I felt like that was a defining moment where the quality of tennis took a giant leap."

Nick won the High school State Championship in Illinois and was awarded National High School Tennis All-American in 1987. After a successful junior career, Nick was invited to play tennis for Ole Miss in 1991-92 where he played the #1 singles and doubles position. His senior year, he won the Texas Invitational tournament, earned runner-up honors in the National Clay Court Championships, and represented the Rebels in the NCAA tournament. Nick was ranked as high as #5 in the NCAA rankings during his senior year and finished 11th. He was selected to the All-SEC Team and became the 3rd All- American tennis player in Ole Miss history. Nick was inducted into the Ole Miss Sports Hall of Fame in 2006. Post college, he traveled the world competing on the Pro Tour in Satellite tournaments from 1992 1994.

After his stint on the Pro Tour, Nick's Mississippi ties brough

him to Jackson and he has spent his life contributing to the local tennis community. Nick has over 22 years of service at the Country Club of Jackson and currently serves as the Director of Racquet Sports. In 2019, Nick was awarded the Mississippi Tennis Professional of the Year.

Nick is married to Wanda, and they have 2 children, Nicholas & Lee. Nick feels that Mississippi tennis has grown and will continue to grow in the future through the efforts of the MTA and the pros in Mississippi. Nick always credits the Mississippi pros for their dedication to the sport and personal care of their students. Nick believes these same pros, over the years played a significant role in his growth as an instructor and coach. Above all, Nick is grateful for his faith in Jesus and the gift of grace offered through Christ.

"I felt like God gave me talent specifically for tennis. The sport allowed me to identify with something that was going to have long lasting positive impact in my life. Tennis has afforded me the opportunity to travel the world and see places that I would never have gotten to see, as well as meeting all kinds of people and developing friendships that I hold dear to this day."

When asked about the legacy he wants to leave in the sport, Barone responded, "I don't want to be remembered for my playing skills or achievements, but for my role in enhancing lives through tennis. There is something special about introducing the sport to someone and getting them to love it. It always puts a smile on my face to see someone today that I can remember giving them their first lesson 20 years ago."

Louis Nash has been a big name in Mississippi High School Tennis for almost 40 years, and is one of the first inductees into the Hall of Fame from the high school coaching ranks. Nash started his high school tennis coaching career at RH Watkins High School in Laurel from 1982-1984.

"I was the basketball coach at R.H. Watkins High in Laurel and there was an opening for the tennis position that spring. Having played tennis in high school, I jumped right on it and have never regretted that move!"

Nash's next move was to his hometown of Greenville where he was head coach at Greenville St. Joseph High School from 1986-1993. In his time at Greenville St Joseph, he was part of 5 state championships and was awarded the 1991 MAC (Mississippi Association of Coaches) Coach of the Year. In 2001,

Nash was named the Oxford High School tennis head coach and has been there since. He's led Oxford to 10 State Team Championships and was awarded his second MAC Coach of the Year in 2009.

Over his 32-year coaching career, Nash has a dual match record of 549-60 and has won 15 State Team Championships and 2 overall Big 8 Championships. He's won 28 region or division titles and coached players to 61 state individual championships. Nash was the National Chairman of the National High School Athletic Coaches Association Tennis Committee and USTA Southern High School Tennis Committee Chair from 2016-2018. Louis is married to Rose, who's a teacher at Oxford High. They have 2 kids. Sarah & Bo. who both played collegiate tennis.

Nash has seen a lot of tennis in his 40 years as a coach, and a lot of positive changes in the game, especially in high school tennis.

"The rules of high school tennis have improved over the years, from allowing more coaching during the year, to adding a doubles court to the format to allow more kids an opportunity to play, to the best players emphasizing the importance of playing on their high school teams."

Nash doesn't like to talk much about his legacy in the game yet since he's still got many years of coaching left in him, but he did share some of the reasons why the game has been so rewarding to him.

"Hopefully we've impacted a lot of kids to play tennis for years to come, and will eventually fill out the USTA League teams and college club teams of the future. But what I'd most like to be remembered as is a guy that made a difference in a young person's life, and in a small way led to positive development in coaches, youngsters, and communities that I've been involved with."





The Mississippi Tennis Association is proud to announce that the recipients of the 2022 College Educational Scholarships are **Sunny Logan** of Steens and **Joseph "Mac" Hamilton** of Greenville. Now in its twenty-second year, the program awards scholarships each year to a deserving young man and woman based on their accomplishments in the classroom, on the tennis court, and in the community.



Sunny is a graduate of Caledonia High, and has an impressive resume off the court that includes a 4.0 GPA, being named a Star Student and making Honor Roll each year from 9th-12th grade, Class President, and Homecoming Queen. But as impressive as her resume is off the court, her on court resume is perhaps more impressive as she finished her career with 80 consecutive wins in high school tennis and four consecutive individual state championships in the MHSAA Class 4A Division.

After trying nearly "every" sport and activity growing up, Logan immediately fell in love with tennis at age 5 after her mother entered her into a local tennis camp. "I loved tennis from the start, and that you always got to play against and meet someone new," said Logan. "Unlike team sports, you are responsible for your own mistakes and I loved that all of the practice, work and time you put in showed up and affected your performance."

Logan had immediate success in the sport, but hit a life changing road block at age 9 when she was diagnosed with a rare form of cancer; Burkitt's Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma. That began along battle of beating cancer that involved a 9-month stay at St Jude with 43 rounds of chemo, 14 spinal taps, and 2 bone marrow biopsies. But

through it all, Logan had a great attitude and now attributes the experience to giving her a fresh outlook and perspective on life and tennis.

"It was really hard at first, my body was really weak and it took over a year to gain back my strength," Logan said. "But that really made me realize how blessed and fortunate I was and not to take anything for granted going forward."

The next stop in Logan's career will take her to William Carey University, where she will play collegiate tennis as well as start her pursuit of a nursing career. Her experience at St Jude and the impact that those nurses made on her life influenced her to want to pass that experience on to others.



Jacob Joseph McLaurin "Mac" Hamilton of Greenville is a recent graduate of Deer Creek School, and has an extensive resume of academic, extracurricular, and on court accolades. In addition to carrying a 3.4 GPA, Hamilton's list of extracurricular accomplishments is vast and includes being the Wendy's Heisman Award Winner for Deer Creek, the Jack Potter Memorial Award, the DAR Good Citizen Award, the MAIS STEM Virtual Reality Individual State Champion, as well as becoming an Eagle Scout and being awarded the Chickasaw BSA Council Merit Award. With all of the extracurricular activities, awards, and clubs too numerous to list, it's hard to see how Hamilton made time for tennis, but he did that as well, becoming the MAIS Boys Singles State Champion. Tennis was one of Hamilton's first loves and has had a major impact on his life, as he began playing at age 8.

"My Dad was probably the biggest reason that I got involved playing tennis," said Hamilton. "Tennis is a big deal in the Delta, both of my parents play, and I always remember going to play with my Dad on Monday nights. After I got involved in my first youth camp, it developed my love for the sport even more seeing all the older players and looking up to them."

Hamilton began playing USTA tournaments around the age of 10, and has been playing competitively ever since. He credits tennis as the activity that has helped form some of the most lasting relationships in his life.

"Some of my closest friendships and family bonds have come through tennis," said Hamilton "Tennis has allowed me to see many different parts of the Southeast, meet a lot of different people, and share the love and commonality that we all have for the game."

Hamilton has played many other team and individual sports and taken part in a vast array of activities in high school, but says that tennis stands out as the most unique sport of all that he has tried.

"What makes tennis unique is that it's just you out there and to me that mentally sets it apart from the other sports," Hamilton said. "Your coaches aren't out there with you, so you have to think for yourself, motivate yourself, problem solve, and be strong mentally as well as physically."

The next step in Mac's life will take him to Mississippi State University, where he plans to major in Business Economics and eventually go on to law school. Hamilton's Boy Scout Master took his troop to a trial many years ago, which led him to become fascinated with the law, the Constitution, and the judicial system. But long after Hamilton starts practicing law, he hopes to continue playing tennis and influencing others to do the same.

"You can play tennis at age 5 or age 75, so I hope to be playing for a long time," Hamilton said. "I look forward to spreading my passion for the game to others and sharing with them the impact that it has made on my life."

How does it work?

USTA Junior Team Tennis is one of the fastest growing team sports in the country, and allows kids ages 5-18 to form teams with anywhere from 8 to 16 of their friends at the Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced levels. Those that advance out of local play have an opportunity to progress to State, Sectional, and National Championship events. Leagues have the option to use multiple different formats that are a fit with their community, and scoring can be done in a unique way as well. Teams that win the most total games in the entire team match are named the match winner, so remember, in Junior Team Tennis, EVERY GAME COUNTS.

USTA Jr Team Tennis Highlights

USTA JR Team Tennis will now have three state Championship opportunities. The new Spring Jr Team Tennis will kick off in March, and qualifying teams will advance to the Mississippi JTT Spring Championship May 6-7. This league will be coed and the format will be mixed doubles which will consist of a girls doubles, a boys doubles, and a mixed court.

The traditional Summer Jr Team Tennis season will kick off in June, and qualifying teams will advance to the Mississippi JTT State Championship August 4-6. That league will be coed and the format will be boys and girls singles, and boys and girls doubles.

In the Fall Jr team Tennis League, boys and girls teams are separate, and team matches consist of 4 singles and 2 doubles matches. The Fall JTT League will conclude with a Fall State Championship November 18-19.
