- Any equipment purchased through this grant will be the property of the Parks and Recreation Agency in the event that the partnership is terminated
- All grant applications must be <u>completed and submitted online</u>
- All applicants MUST submit a complete grant application form that includes a description of the program, program objectives, evaluation methods and program budget.
- The number of grants awarded is based on available budgeted funds.
- Applying organizations must be open to all people, regardless of race, color, creed, religion, gender, national origin, age, disability, sexual orientation, citizenship status, or veteran status.
